MTH PRESIDENT, RILEY SAYLOR'S MESSAGE-APRIL

Well, it's the day after the March membership meeting. Two months have passed since taking office and so far everything seems to be going well. The weather is finally getting a little better and the ground is thawed enough to start some serious metal detecting. I'm sure April's Find of the Month tables will be full of great finds.

Lately I have been getting emails about how to tell if someone is having a stroke, and have even read about it in another detecting clubs' newsletter. So I am going to pass this information on to you. Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. But it was discovered that a group of non-medical volunteers could identify facial weakness, arm weakness and speech problems by asking three simple questions. So if you are with someone who may be stumbling, or doesn't seem to be their self ask the following three questions:

1. Ask the person to smile.
2. Ask the person to raise both arms.
3. Ask the person to speak a simple question.

If the person has trouble with any of these questions call 911 and give details to the dispatcher. You may just save the life of a friend or loved one by knowing these simple questions. Pass this along to your friends and relatives so we can all be able to help each other.

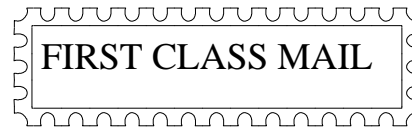
