**MEDAL DETECTED**

If it hadn't been for a treasure hunter scanning a muddy Detroit River bank with a metal detector, a rare medal believed to date to the War of 1812 may have been lost forever. Although the medal's history is somewhat difficult to trace because of how it was found, experts at Bonham's auctioneers in London believe the silver medalion minted for a Canadian First Nations chief is a rare find. "They are quite scarce," said Andrew Litherland, an expert on coins and medals at Bonhams. He estimates that only a few hundred may still be in existence— and they rarely come up for sale. The medal is expected to fetch up to \$10,000. Does anyone have more info on this story? Would be interesting to know who found the medal and where.

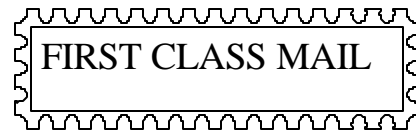

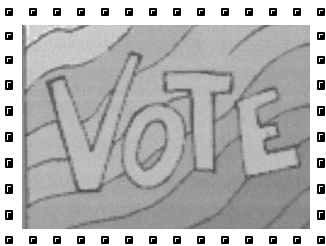

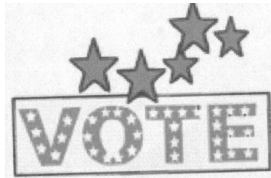
